The Tootinaowaziibeeng Treaty Reserve (TTR) Duck and Grouse Camp is back this fall 2023. This is a special initiative under the TTR Traditional Knowledge Center for Climate Change. During Phase II of this initiative, we are expecting to continue to address the different issues and barriers to accessing traditional foods, as well as to create a new opportunity for Elders and youth to come together to build awareness and talk about the effects of Climate Change concerning traditional food sources.

Due to safety and supervisory reasons, the Duck & Goose Camp will host a limited number of youth participants. Please review the requirements indicated on the next page.

Please also note that due to the limited number of spots available, registration is on a first come first serve basis.

All hunting supplies and food are included in the program.

Participants of the TTR Duck & Goose Camp are required to wear weather appropriate clothing and footwear, as it is cold and often damp in the mornings.
