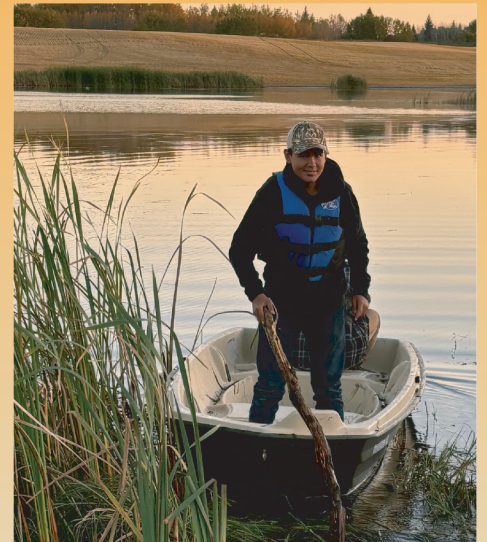
The Tootinaowazibeeng Treaty Reserve (TTR) Duck and Goose Camp is back this fall 2025.

During Phase IV of this initiative, we are expecting to continue to address the different issues and barriers to accessing traditional foods, as well as to create a new opportunity for Elders and youth to come together to build awareness and talk about the effects of Climate Change concerning traditional food sources.

Due to safety and supervisory reasons, the Duck & Goose Camp will host a limited number of youth participants. Registration will be available at the Band Office at the end of August, please make sure you send your registration form before September 15th, 2025. Due to the limited number of spots available, registration is on a first come first serve basis.

All hunting supplies and food are included in the program.

Participants of the TTR Duck & Goose Camp are required to wear weather appropriate clothing and footwear, as it is cold and often damp in the mornings.
