The Tootinaowazieeng Treaty Reserve (TTR) Duck & Goose Camp is back this fall!

This year's program will continue to address some of the barriers community members face in accessing traditional foods, while creating opportunities for Elders and youth to come together, share knowledge, and discuss the impacts of climate change on traditional food sources, wildlife, and the land.

Through hands-on activities, participants will have opportunities to learn and strengthen traditional skills related to hunting, harvesting, and food preparation while spending time together on the land.

Due to safety and supervision requirements, a limited number of spaces are available for youth participants. Registration forms are available at the Band Office and must be submitted by September 15, 2026.

All hunting supplies, equipment, and meals required for the program will be provided.

Participants should come prepared for outdoor activities and are required to wear weather-appropriate clothing and footwear. Fall mornings can be cold and damp, so warm layers and suitable outdoor footwear are strongly recommended.
